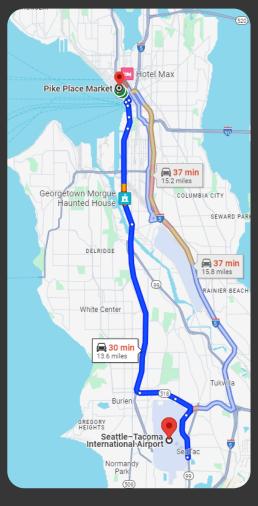

Parking & Finding the Gum Wall

Parking in Seattle, especially near Pike Place Market, can be a bit of a challenge. Your best bet is to use one of the paid parking garages in the area. The Pike Place Market Garage offers convenient access but fills up quickly. If that's full, there are other garages and street parking options nearby, but be prepared for potential meter fees and traffic.

Once you've conquered parking, finding the famous Pike Place Market sign is easy. It's a landmark, so just follow the crowds. To reach the Gum Wall, head towards the waterfront side of the market. You can't miss the colorful, sticky spectacle!

If you've got a little extra time, consider stretching your legs with a walk to the iconic Space Needle. It's about a 24-minute stroll from Pike Place Market. This walk takes you through the heart of Seattle, offering a chance to soak up the city's vibe. You'll pass by other attractions and get a feel for the local neighborhood. Just remember, the Space Needle requires tickets, so plan ahead if you want to ascend to the top for panoramic views of the city.





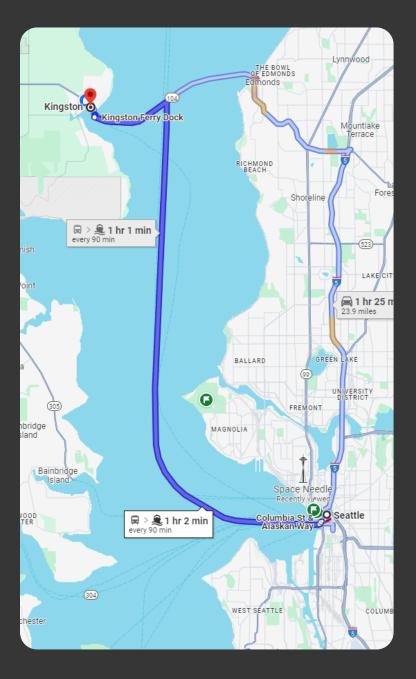


SEATTLE TO KINSTON WA

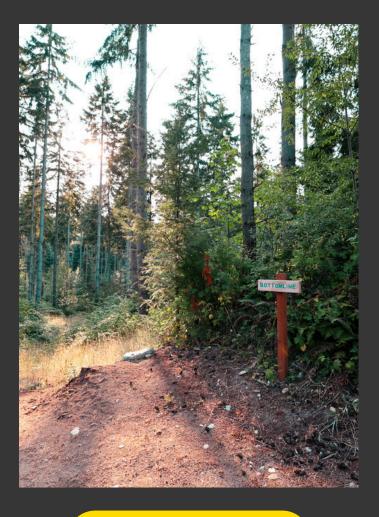

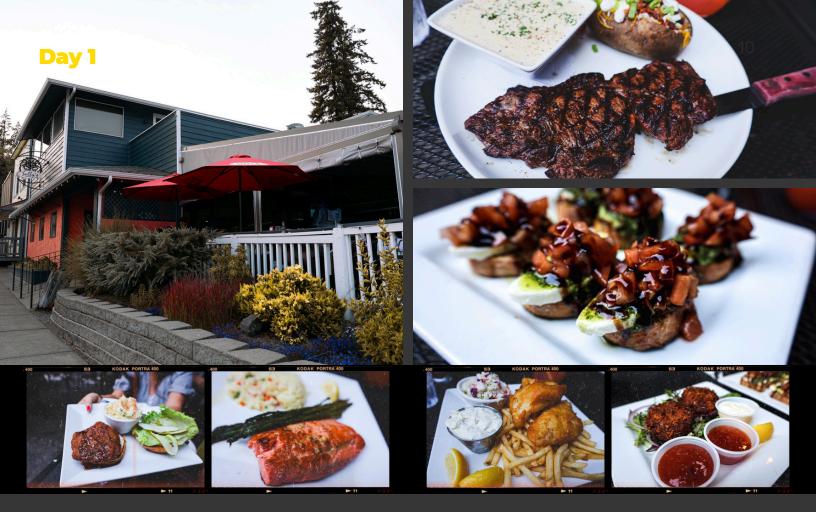




Check Airbnb Availability

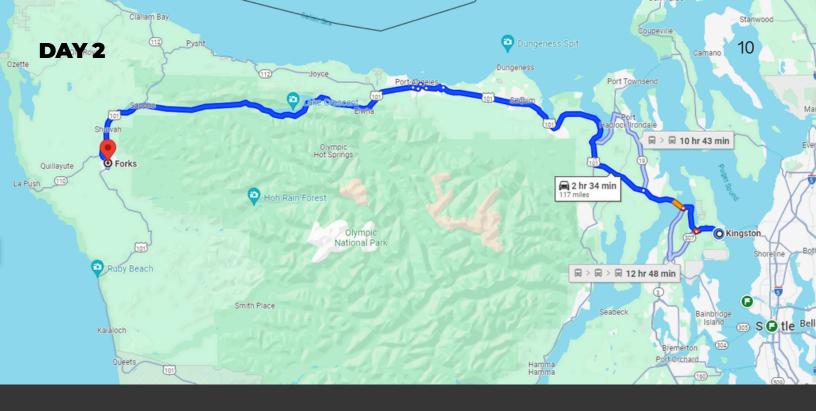


We indulged in a decadent Nutella crepe topped with fresh strawberries and bananas, and finished it off with a generous dollop of whipped cream. It was pure bliss.

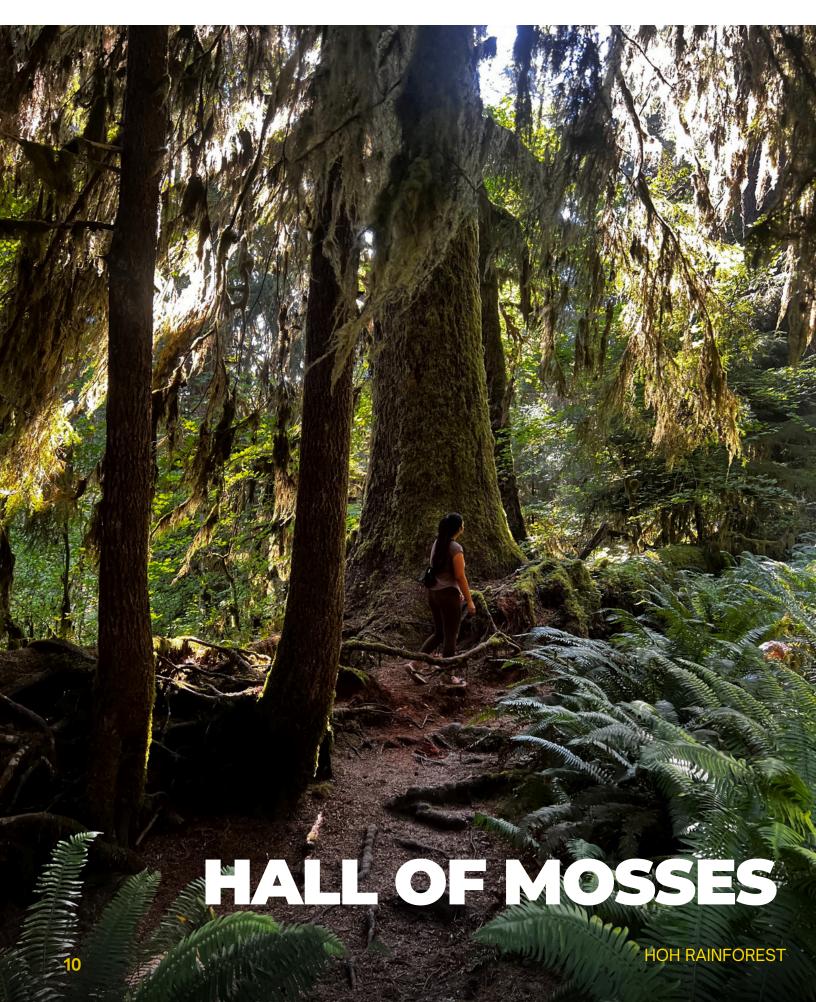


ROADTRIP TO FORKS, WA

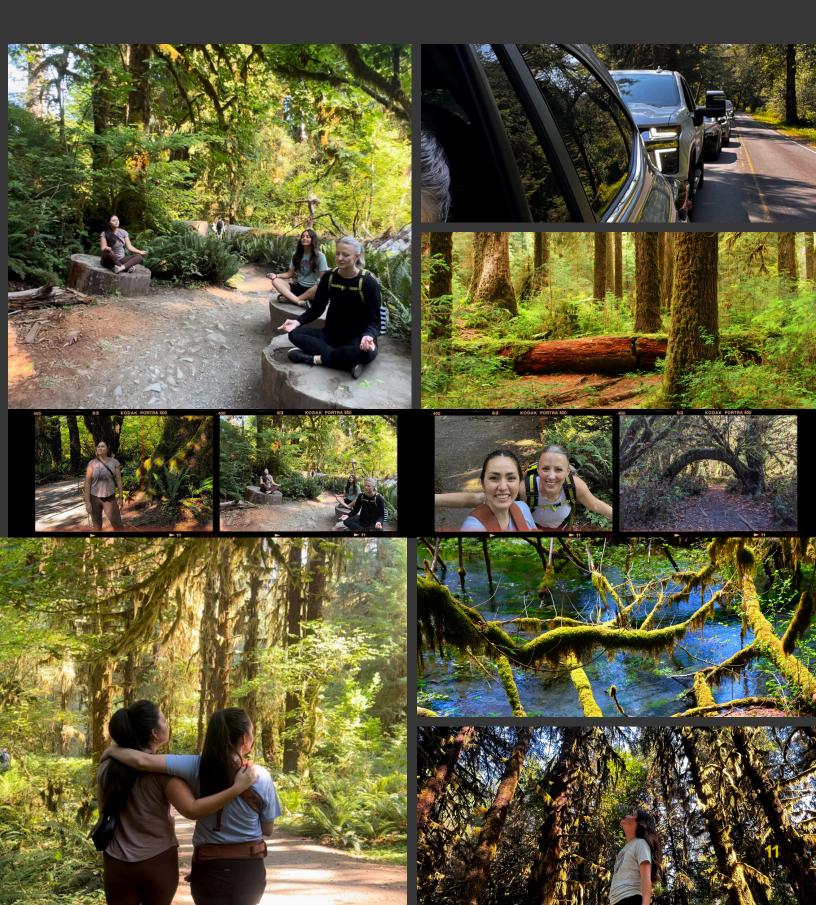

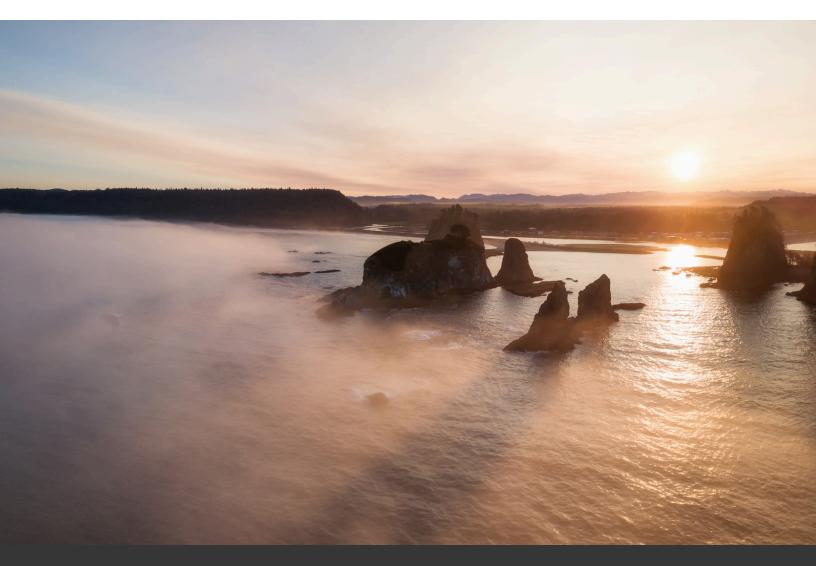
Ruby Beach

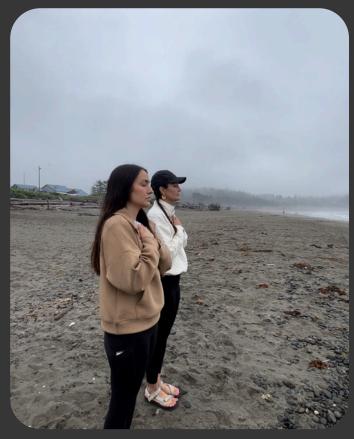
Yoga on the beach & Manifestation Guide

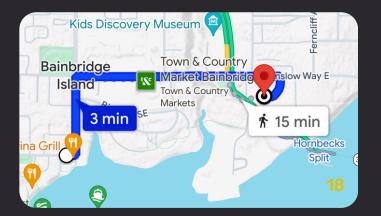

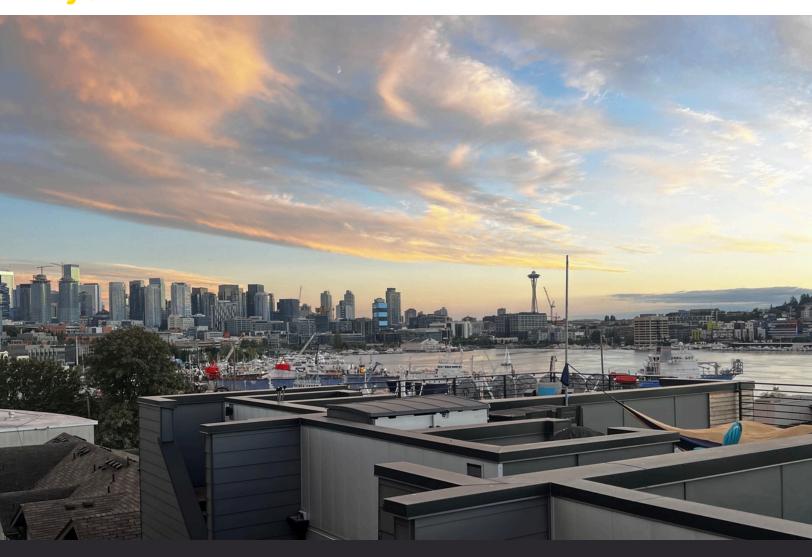
Pegasus Coffee in Bainbridge Island, WA

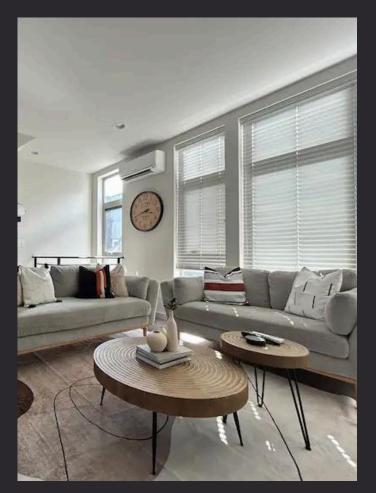


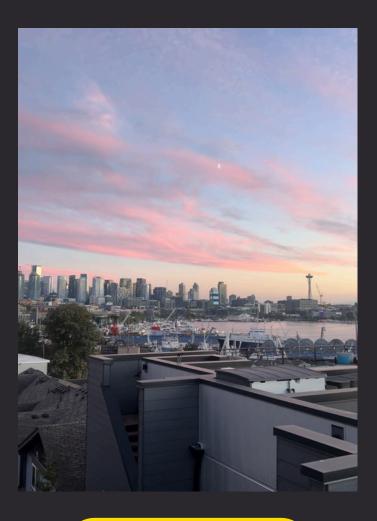












Check Airbnb Availability

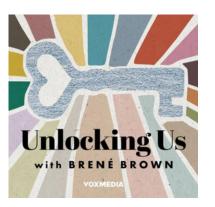

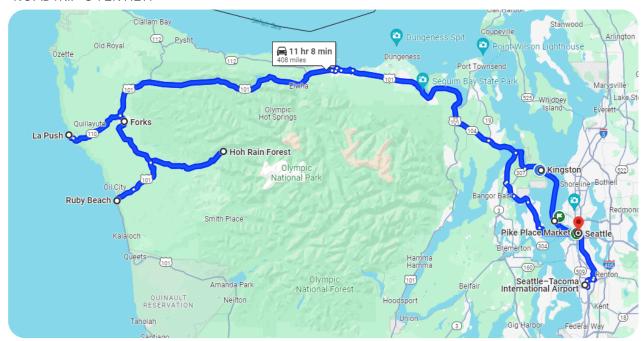
